Trans-Atlantic Overnight

Due to Trans-Atlantic misconnects on return travel, an overnight in Europe may be required by the airline. Hotels and meals during overnight in Europe are not paid for by the airline, and thus are not included in cost of the trip.

Cancellation Policy

From 45 days to departure or less, the cancellation fee will be the \$200.00 non-refundable deposit plus any fees imposed by airlines (could amount to 75% of the trip). All cancellations must be received in writing and no refund can be made for services not used once trip has commenced or for no shows. Should a catastrophic event beyond HopeHouse International, Inc./Together International, Inc.'s control cause the trip to be cancelled, refunds, if any, are subject to the refunds made available by airlines.
